### **IAPMO Seeks *UMC* Factory-Made Air Duct Task Group Members**

**Ontario, Calif. (Oct. 30, 2017)** – The International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials (IAPMO) is accepting applications and seeking technical experts to participate on a task group relating to factory-made air ducts.

The scope of the Factory-Made Duct Task Group is to review how the term “factory-made air ducts” is referenced throughout the *Uniform Mechanical Code (UMC)* and to review products that fall under this category. The objective is to provide an in-depth analysis and develop recommendations for the *UMC* Technical Committee for consideration.

Task group members will participate via conference call or web meeting, provide their perspective on the code, and assist in drafting recommendations for action by the *UMC* Technical Committee’s consideration. Applicants are not required to be members of the *UMC* Technical Committee.
